The objective of this plan is for Opta to determine the technical and economic feasibility of each option to determine which, if any, are viable for implementation at this time.

Opta is a coal slag processing and packaging facility. The Facility receives granular slag, which is screened for debris, dried and (depending on the customer) mixed with sands before being packaged and shipped.
